LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

CANADIAN AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS ASSOCIATION (CATCA UNIFOR LOCAL 5454)

"The Union"

and

NAV CANADA

"The Company"

Whereas:

- 1. Article 20.04 of the CATCA collective agreement states that no employee in a control position shall work more than nine (9) consecutive days unless in an emergency situation; and
- 2. The parties are in agreement that the period of rest after nine (9) consecutive days shall be a calendar day in all cases for employees in control positions;

The parties hereby agree:

- 1. Any CATCA employee who has worked a control position for nine (9) consecutive days must take a full calendar day off; and
- 2. The calendar day of rest shall have no hours work scheduled from 00:00 to 23:59 inclusive; and.
- 3. Article 20.04 of the collective agreement shall be amended to read;

20.04 Except in an emergency, no employee in a control position shall work more than twelve (12) consecutive hours or more than nine (9) consecutive days. Any employee who has worked nine (9) consecutive days in a control position shall be scheduled a full calendar day of rest. For clarity, no work shall be scheduled between 00:00 and 23:59 on the day of rest.

4. This change shall be effective commencing January 1, 2020.
