- 3. Proof of enrollment in a full-time post-secondary educational program for the upcoming school year
- 4. A Curriculum Vitae outlining work experience, past achievements, and volunteer work
- 5. 150-200 words outlining what their personal contributions to society have been
- 6. 150-200 words outlining what contributions they intend to make to society in their adult life
- 7. Two (2) signed letters of recommendation from **non-family members'** familiar with applicant's abilities

Complete submissions must be received by <u>mail</u> (<u>email will not be accepted</u>) on or before Wednesday, <u>August 31, 2022</u>. Submissions should be sent using a trackable mail service. <u>ADDRESS: 2-1312 Leaside Ave, Ottawa ON, K1Z 7R1</u>

All applications will have personal identification removed and be forwarded to the Selection Committee who will select the winners. The winners will be notified and their name will be published on the CATCA member's access site of our website.
