We are pleased to inform you of some minor changes that will improve how we communicate with you. Our goal to save time and resources while providing you with one convenient stop for all union updates.

Effective immediately, Branch and Facility Updates/Broadcasts will now be emailed to you directly from the CATCA National Office rather than forwarded from your Branch Chair or RVP email accounts. Please watch for emails coming from **communications@catca.ca**— and be sure to add this address to your safe sender list so you don't miss any notifications. **PLEASE NOTE:** your email address will remain confidential and will not be shared with other recipients.

Looking ahead, our goal is to transition all union updates and notifications to be delivered through the **CATCA App**. We will inform you well ahead of time before the transition, as we work on expanding the app functionality. In the meantime, please make sure you download the app, if you haven't done so already. A quick reminder of how to set up the App follows below.
